

Bolivian Minister Says Fidel Castro 'A Man of Principles and High Values'



La Paz, December 4 (RHC)-- The Bolivian Minister of Economy Luis Arce said that Fidel Castro represents the Latin American revolution. "He was a man who persevered and achieved his goals on the basis of maintaining his principles and values."
