India's President Ram Nath Kovind visits Cuba



Havana, June 21 (RHC)-- India's President Ram Nath Kovind arrives this Thursday in Cuba to pay an official visit.

The Indian leader's agenda includes a meeting with his Cuban counterpart Miguel Diaz-Canel, as well as the signing of agreements in biotechnology and traditional and alternative medicine
