Crucial Victory of Cuito Cuanavale Recalled in Angola



Luanda, March 24 (RHC)-- The victory of Cuito Cuanavale, which this Sunday turned 26, was crucial to maintain the sovereign of Angola and contributed to the liberation of Namibia and Zimbabwe, governor of the province Cuando Cubango.

Higinio Carneiro affirmed during his participation in the international conference for the 26th anniversary of the Cuito Cuanavale victory.
