ExpoCaribe successfully concludes in Santiago de Cuba



Santiago de Cuba, June 24 (RHC)-- The 16th ExpoCaribe trade fair came to an end over the weekend but we left Cuba's doors open for the promotion of new business ventures, said Antonio Luis Carricarte, first vice minister of Foreign Trade and Foreign Investment.

Carricarte said that this edition raised the expectations of Cuban and foreign companies, which should continue negotiations for the benefit of the parties.
