

Russia says U.S. approach to Middle East is destructive and against international law



Moscow, July 30 (RHC)-- The Russian Ministry of Foreign Affairs has denounced Washington's position on the Palestinian-Israeli conflict as destructive and contrary to the approaches of the majority of the members of the international community.

"The destructive position of the U.S. once again demonstrates the line aimed at breaking the internationally recognized legal framework for Middle East agreements," according to the Russian Foreign Ministry.

This comes as U.S. representatives to the United Nations blocked an attempt by Kuwait, Indonesia, and South Africa to get the Security Council to condemn Israel's destruction of Palestinian homes in East Jerusalem, despite fierce objection from the international community.

According to the Russian ministry, a possible settlement for the Palestinian-Israeli conflict has been taken hostage by the unilateral approaches of the United States. As the U.S. continues its argument that the United Nations has anti-Israel bias, in a tactic to shield Israel's human rights and international law violations.
