Protesters call out G-7 leaders over corporate ties, climate inaction and inequality

Whether it be Trump, Macron, Trudeau, Merkel or the others, they all have the same policies in service of the rich and multinationals. We're opposing them with values of solidarity, with answers to the environmental crisis and respect of human rights and the end of relationships of domination."
