

Appointed new Baseball Comisioner in Cuba



Havana, September 11 (RHC) - The Cuban Institute of Sports (INDER) appointed Ernesto Reynoso, who has a vast experience as baseball official and teacher, as new Baseball Comisioner in Cuba, in substitution of former Sancti Spiritus Roosters pitcher Yovani Aragon.

A note sent to the press, the INDER informed about the appointing of Reynoso and said that "other tasks will be assigned" to Aragon. The document explains that "Reynoso was First Secretary of the Cuban Communist Party in Isla de la Juventud until last June, being recognized for the boost given by him to the territory in economic, political, and social matters".

The substitution of Aragon as Baseball Comissioner happens a month after the ending of the Lima 2019 Pan-Am Games, in which the Cuban Baseball team had their worst result in the history of the sport in Cuba, finishing 6th with 1 win and 3 losses, and after a year of poor results, especially in the exhibition matches against United States and Nicaragua.
