In 2000, the Council of State of the Republic of Cuba awarded Alonso the country's highest decoration, the José Martí Order, and in 2015, the same entity decided to rename the Gran Teatro de La Habana with the

name of the distinguished Cuban dancer, teacher, and choreographer.
