

Cuban president meets with U.S. religious leaders



Havana, November 26 (RHC)-- Cuba's President Miguel Diaz-Canel welcomed on Monday Rudelmar Bueno and James E. Winkler, general secretaries of the United States Joint Alliance of Churches and the National Council of the Churches of Christ, respectively.
