
John Bolton willing to testify in Senate impeachment trial of Trump



Washington, January 8 (RHC)-- Former White House national security adviser John Bolton has said he would be willing to testify at President Donald Trump's impeachment trial in the Senate, if he is subpoenaed.

Bolton's statement increases the pressure on Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell and other Republicans to agree to call witnesses in Trump's Senate trial. McConnell has previously said he will not call witnesses, that he will coordinate the trial with the White House and that he is not an impartial juror.
