Venezuelan president requests \$5 billion from IMF to fight coronavirus



Caracas, March 18 (RHC)-- Venezuela's Foreign Minister Jorge Arreaza reported on Tuesday that the government of President Nicolas Maduro asked the International Monetary Fund (IMF) for a financing facility for \$5 billion U\$D from the emergency fund of the Rapid Financing Instrument (RFI).
