

Ten new cases reported with COVID-19 in Cuba



Havana, March 22 (RHC)-- The Cuban Ministry of Public Health,(MINSAP) reported on Sunday the diagnosis of 10 new cases of COVID-19 in the country, bringing the number to 35.

The head of MINSAP's Communicable Diseases Department, Jose Raul de Armas, explained that 954 patients have been admitted to the isolation and care centers created for clinical-epidemiological surveillance; 255 of them are foreigners and 727 Cubans.

Another 30,773 people are being monitored by the primary health care system from their homes.

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
