

Raising the flags for Cuba's frontliners fighting Covid-19 pandemic



A recently released tune entitled 'Raise the Flags' -or in Spanish 'Izar banderas'- is a tribute to Cuban health personnel fighting, day and night, the Covid-19 pandemic on the island and around the world.
