

Cuba reports 20 new cases of COVID-19 over the past 24 hours



Havana, April 27 (RHC)-- The National Director of Epidemiology of the Cuban Ministry of Public Health, Dr. Francisco Duran, reported that there were 20 new cases of COVID-19, for an total of 1,389 positive cases across the island.

During his daily press briefing held Monday morning, Duran said that over the past 24 hours -- up to 12 midnight Sunday night -- unfortunately, two patients died from the coronavirus. There are now a total of 56 who have died from COVID-19 in Cuba.

To date, 525 patients have recovered -- with an additional 24 released from hospitals on Sunday.
