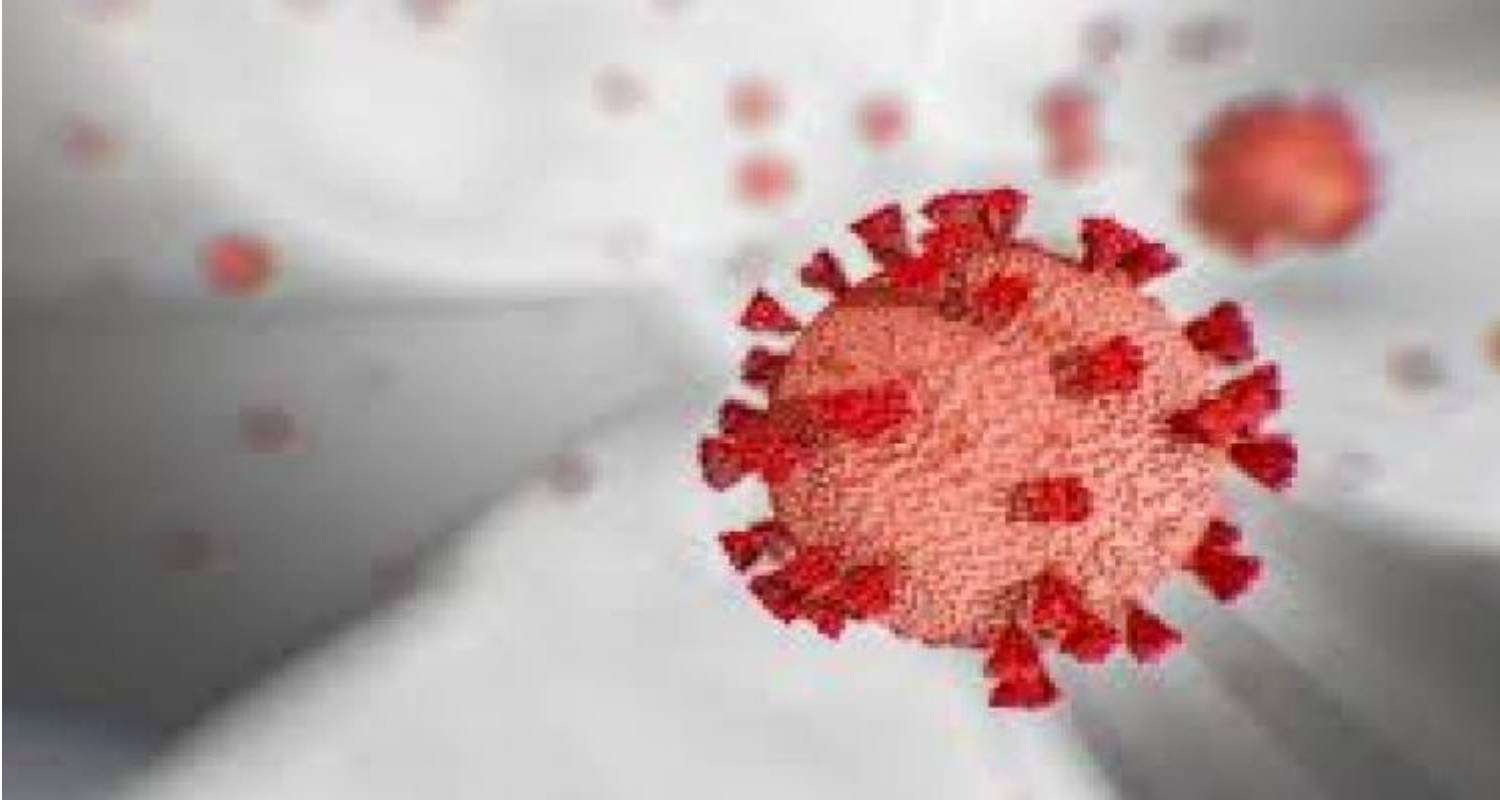


Doctors see rise in strokes caused by COVID-19
