

French professor highlights José Martí's enduring lesson in dignity



Paris, May 19 (RHC)-- Cuba's National Hero José Martí represents an imperishable lesson of dignity, assumed by the government and the people of the island in the face of aggressions, said French professor Paul Estrade in Paris.

In an interview with Prensa Latina, on the 125th anniversary of the death of the independence hero, Estrade said that Martí left more than an example, a lesson of moral and ethical conduct, and how to act in a dignified and decent manner.
