

Cuba reports 38 new cases of COVID-19 over the past 24 hours



Havana, June 1 (RHC)-- The National Director of Epidemiology of the Cuban Ministry of Public Health, Dr. Francisco Duran, reported that there were 38 new cases of COVID-19, for an total of 2,083 positive cases across the island.

During his daily press briefing held Monday morning, Dr. Duran said that over the past 24 hours -- up to 12 midnight Sunday night -- fortunately, no patients died from the coronavirus. A total of 83 patients have died from COVID-19 in Cuba over the past several months.

To date, 1,826 patients have recovered -- with an additional 17 patients released from hospitals during the day on Sunday.
