

WHO Americas director says concerned pandemic surging in new areas in Latin America



Geneva, June 10 (RHC)-- The World Health Organization's regional director for the Americas Carissa Etienne has said that data has raised concerns that coronavirus cases are surging in new places in Latin America as some areas show "exponential" rises.

Etienne cited a rising number of cases in countries including Mexico, Panama, Costa Rica, Brazil, Peru, Chile, Venezuela, Haiti and Surinam.
