

Italy reports 34 deaths, 210 new cases



Rome, June 17 (RHC)-- Coronavirus-related deaths in Italy has risen by 34, compared to 26 the day before, the Civil Protection Agency has said, while new cases have decreased to 210 from 303 on Monday.

The total death toll stands at 34,405, the agency said, the fourth highest in the world after those of the United States, Britain and Brazil.

There are currently 237,500 confirmed cases, the seventh highest in the world.
