



Meanwhile, a small outbreak of COVID-19 cases has prompted authorities to reclose schools in the central Cuban province of Ciego de Avila, only a week after they opened.

The province's school director, Bárbara Rodríguez, said 75 of the province's 90 schools would return to televised teaching on Monday. Students had returned to classrooms only on Sept. 1 after a six-month break.

The province has reported 30 new infections with the new coronavirus over the past 15 days.
