Trump vows to veto military spending bill over anger at Twitter and Facebook



Washington, December 5 (RHC)-- U.S. President Donald Trump has tweeted that he will veto the massive \$740 billion National Defense Authorization Act, because Republican senators refused to include an amendment to strip legal protections for social media companies.
