Diaz-Canel calls for the reinforcement of the Communist Party's bases

Havana, Jun 4 (RHC)--The first secretary of the Communist Party of Cuba (PCC), Miguel Díaz-Canel, on Friday called to reinforce the bases of the organization as an essential step to materialize the ideas and concepts of the Party's 8th Congress.
