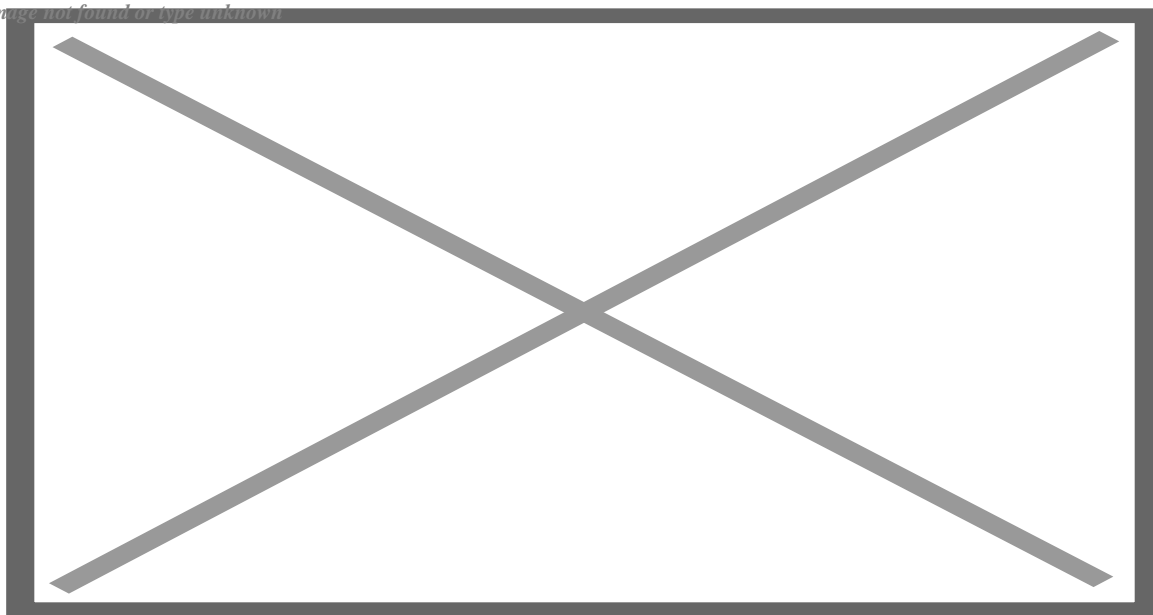


Cuban President receives congratulations on National Rebellion Day

Havana, Jul 26 (RHC)-- The general secretary of the Communist Party of Vietnam (PCV), Nguyen Phu Trong, congratulated on Monday his Cuban counterpart, Miguel Díaz-Canel, on the occasion of the 68th anniversary of the assault on the Moncada and Carlos Manuel de Céspedes barracks.

Vietnamese President Nguyen Xuan Phuc also congratulated the Cuban head of state on National Rebellion Day (July 26).

The historic date was also remembered by Prime Minister Pham Minh Chinh and the head of the National Assembly, who sent messages to their counterparts in the Caribbean nation, Manuel Marrero and Esteban Lazo, respectively.
