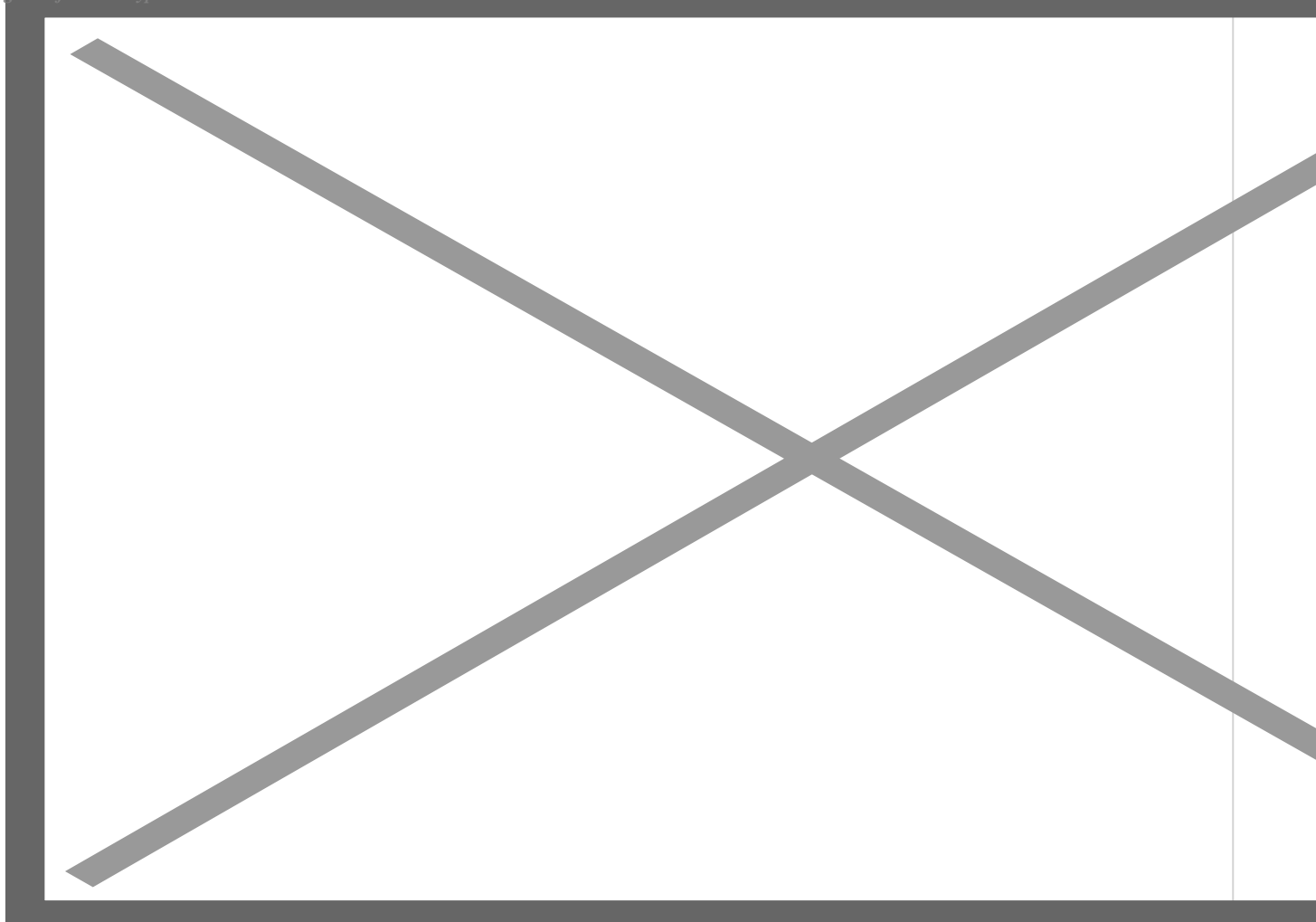


New York City to require proof of vaccine for indoor dining and events
