

Japan donates medical equipment and supplies to Cuba



Tokyo, September 8 (RHC)-- Japanese institutions and Cuban residents here organized a donation of medical supplies and equipment to reinforce the work of Cuba's health system.

The Cuban Embassy in Tokyo explained that as part of the shipment, 25 lung ventilators have already been enlisted with their support carts. They will depart by air from Japan to Cuba in the coming days.

The lung ventilators will be installed in 14 hospitals distributed in 13 of all 16 Cuban provinces, the diplomatic mission added.

This first shipment of medical supplies also includes protective suits, syringes, masks, gloves, and face shields.
