This comes after a member of Bolsonaro's UN delegation tested positive for coronavirus after arriving in New York.

On Monday, New York Mayor Bill de Blasio had this response: "We need to send a message to all the world leaders, including, most notably, Bolsonaro from Brazil, that if you intend to come here, you need to be vaccinated. If you don't want to be vaccinated, don't bother coming."
