

Protesters block port of Miami to demand end to Haiti deportation flights

Miami, October 19 (RHC)-- In Miami, at least 10 immigrant justice advocates were arrested Monday after temporarily blocking the entrance to Port Miami by lying in the roadway. The act of civil disobedience was led by several groups calling on the Biden administration to end the deportation of Haitian asylum seekers and issue permanent and humane immigration relief for millions of people.

Haiti's justice minister says the criminal gang that kidnapped 17 U.S. and Canadian missionaries and their children is asking for \$1 million for each hostage's release. The Biden administration said Monday the FBI was in negotiations with kidnapers from the gang 400 Mawozo.
