New York City Hall to take down racist statue of Thomas Jefferson

New York, October 20 (RHC)-- In New York City, a prominent statue of Thomas Jefferson will be removed from City Hall, after a years-long push from Black and Latinx councilmembers.

New York City Councilmember Adrienne Adams told reporters: "Thomas Jefferson was a slaveholder who owned over 600 human beings, African slaves he reaped the economic benefits of slave labor from. He maintained the notion that Black people were inferior to white people. ... I believe it's time for us as the city to turn the page and move forward."
