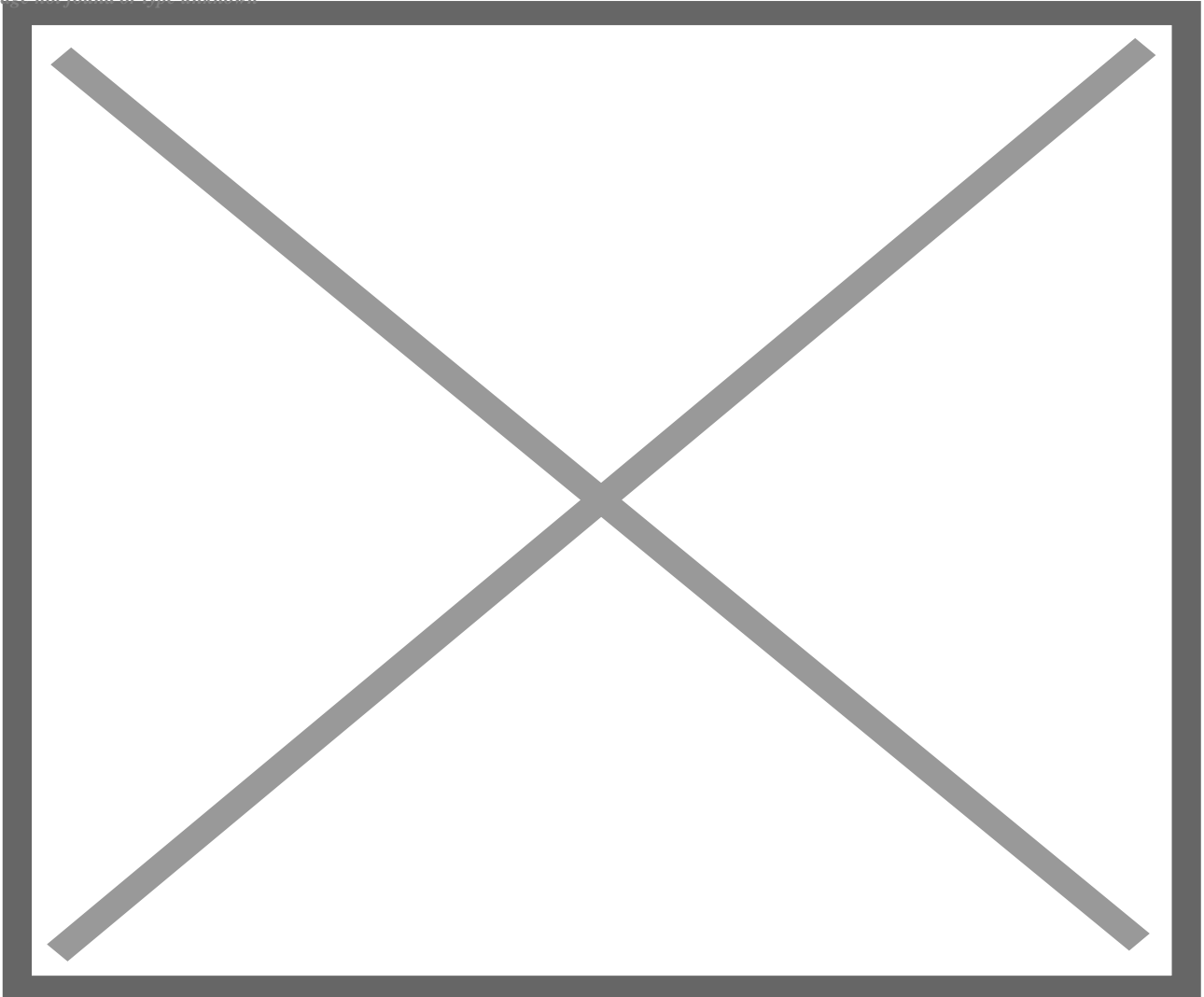


Head of Australia's Walkley Foundation denounces British approval of Julian Assange's extradition
