

Serbia and Cameroon draw with a rain of goals in the World Cup

Doha, November 28 (PL).- The teams of Serbia and Cameroon drew 3-3 today in group G of the Qatar 2022 soccer World Cup and scored their first point in the tournament.

Thousands of fans witnessed the rain of goals at the Al Janoub stadium, which could have been even more fruitful.

Jean-Charles Castelletto, Vincent Aboubakar and Eric Maxim Choupo-Moting scored for the Africans, while Strahinja Pavlovic, Sergej Milinkovic-Savic and Aleksandar Mitrovic scored for the Europeans.

After this result, the Serbians and Cameroonians have one point in the G section and are behind Brazil and Switzerland, who have three points at the top of the standings, with a game in hand.

Brazil and Switzerland will meet later in the day to close the second round of matches in this group.

The members of section H will also play this day, with the duels of Cristiano Ronaldo's Portugal against Luis Suarez's Uruguay and South Korea against Ghana.

On Sunday, Spain and Germany played to a one-goal draw, Costa Rica beat Japan 1-0, runner-up Croatia overcame Canada 4-1 and Morocco caused a surprise by beating Belgium 2-0, a result that provoked riots in the center of Brussels when dozens of fans smashed vehicles and street furniture, forcing the police to intervene.
