
Cuban delegation arrives in Algeria to attend Polisario Front Congress



The Polisario Front Congress will raise the flags against colonialism.

Havana, Jan 10 (RHC) A delegation headed by a member of the Secretariat of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of Cuba (PCC) Yudí Rodríguez Hernández arrived Tuesday in Algiers to attend the 16th Congress of the Polisario Front, to be held from January 13th through the 17th.

Rodríguez Hernández will travel to the Algerian provinces where the Saharawi refugee camps are located, and there she will carry out a political program with the authorities of the Saharawi Arab Democratic Republic (SADR).
