
Spanish Clasico in Copa del Rey



Havana, January 30 (RHC)-- Real Madrid and Barcelona will face each other in a new edition of the Clasico of Spanish soccer, after the draw for the semifinals of the King's Cup, which was held today, also paired Osasuna and Athletic Club de Bilbao.

Merengues and Culés will be rivals for the third time this season after the La Liga duel that favored Real Madrid and the Spanish Super Cup final, where the Catalans won.

The penultimate round of the competition, scheduled to be played over two legs (home and away), will be played in March and April, with dates yet to be set due to calendar adjustments for both teams.

The history of matches between these two giants of world soccer favors Real Madrid 101 successes to Barcelona's 99, with 419 goals scored for Los Merengues and 413 for Los Azulgranas.
