Cubans and Vietnamese celebrated in Hanoi the sixty-second anniversary of the defeat of the mercenary invasion at Playa Girón

Havana, April 19 (RHC) - Cubans and Vietnamese commemorated today in Hanoi the sixty-second anniversary of the crushing defeat suffered by the mercenary invasion of Playa Girón.

The visit of Vuong Dinh Hue, president of the National Assembly of Vietnam, is currently making to Cuba confers a unique character to this celebration, as stated by Ambassador Orlando Hernández in a simple ceremony held at the headquarters of the Cuban state mission in Hanoi on the occasion of the anniversary.

Hernández highlighted the fact that Vuong will be the first foreign leader to address the newly elected National Assembly of People's Power of Cuba, whose constitutive session will take place today.
