

Díaz-Canel attends ceremony to honor Labor Heroes

Havana, April 29 (RHC)-- With the presence of Miguel Díaz-Canel Bermúdez, First Secretary of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of Cuba and President of the Republic, the ceremony for the awarding of decorations granted by the Central de Trabajadores de Cuba (CTC), among them the honorary title of Heroes and Heroines of Labor, began in this capital city.

Accompanying the President were members of the Political Bureau of the CCPCC Manuel Marrero Cruz, Prime Minister of the Republic, Ulises Guilarte de Nacimiento, Secretary General of the CTC, and Teresa Amarrelle Boué, Secretary General of the Federation of Cuban Women, among other representatives of
