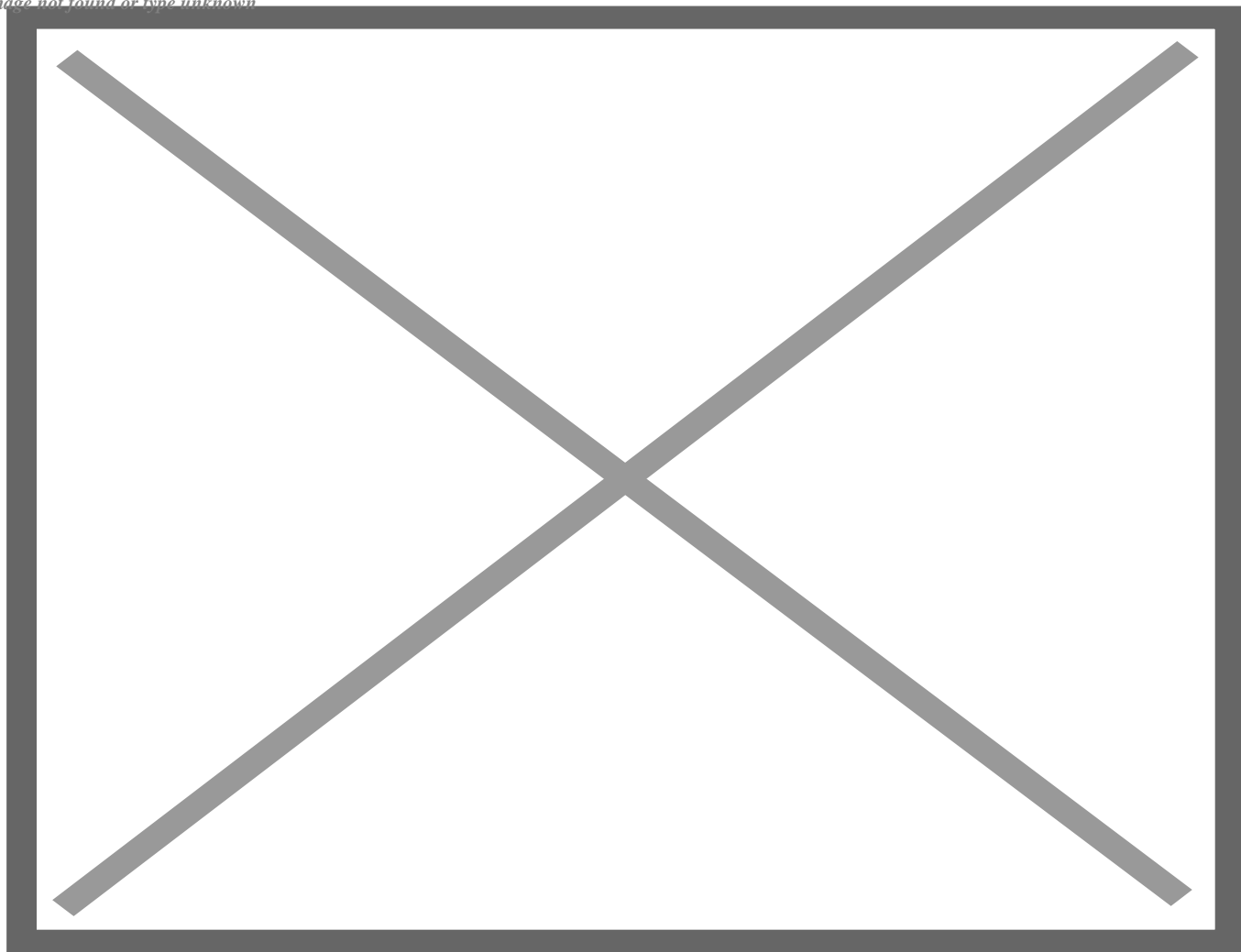


Diaz-Canel attends the closing ceremony of the First International Congress on Cultural Heritage
