
Cuba advocates strengthening bilateral ties and cooperation with South Africa



Havana, May 11 (RHC) Cuba expressed this Thursday its willingness to continue strengthening relations and cooperation with South Africa, in order to celebrate the 29th anniversary of the establishment of bilateral diplomatic ties.

The Cuban Foreign Ministry greeted the date on its Twitter account, and pointed out that both nations will continue working for the mutual benefit of the peoples.
