

Raul Castro and Diaz-Canel preside over gala tribute to Che

Havana, June 14 (RHC)-- The historic leader of the Cuban Revolution, Army General Raúl Castro Ruz, and the First Secretary of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of Cuba and President of the Republic, Miguel Díaz-Canel presided over a gala on Wednesday to celebrate the 95th anniversary of the birth of Ernesto Che Guevara (1928-1967).

At the Universal Hall of the Revolutionary Armed Forces in Havana, music, poetry and dance converged to remember, with the poem "America" by Chilean Pablo Neruda as the main theme, the famous Cuban-Argentine guerrilla fighter.
