

?Earth's average temperature hits all-time high for third consecutive day



New York, July 7 (RC)-- The world's average surface temperature has soared to its highest level ever recorded, surpassing record levels of heat measured just one day earlier — and the day before that.

This week's string of record-shattering hottest days came as climate scientists warned last month was the hottest June ever recorded, with 2023 on track to become the hottest year in human history.

Meanwhile, a new report in the journal *Nature Communications* warns changing weather patterns and extreme heat due to the climate crisis will exacerbate the global food crisis, with lower crop yields anticipated in the near future.
