
Cuba and Laos to Boost Bilateral Relations



Havana, September 19 (RHC) — Laotian President Choummaly Sayasone thanked Cuba for its support of his nation's economic development and national independence struggle, during a meeting with Lazara Mercedes Lopez, member of the Cuban Communist Party's Political Bureau, who paid a working visit to that country this week.
