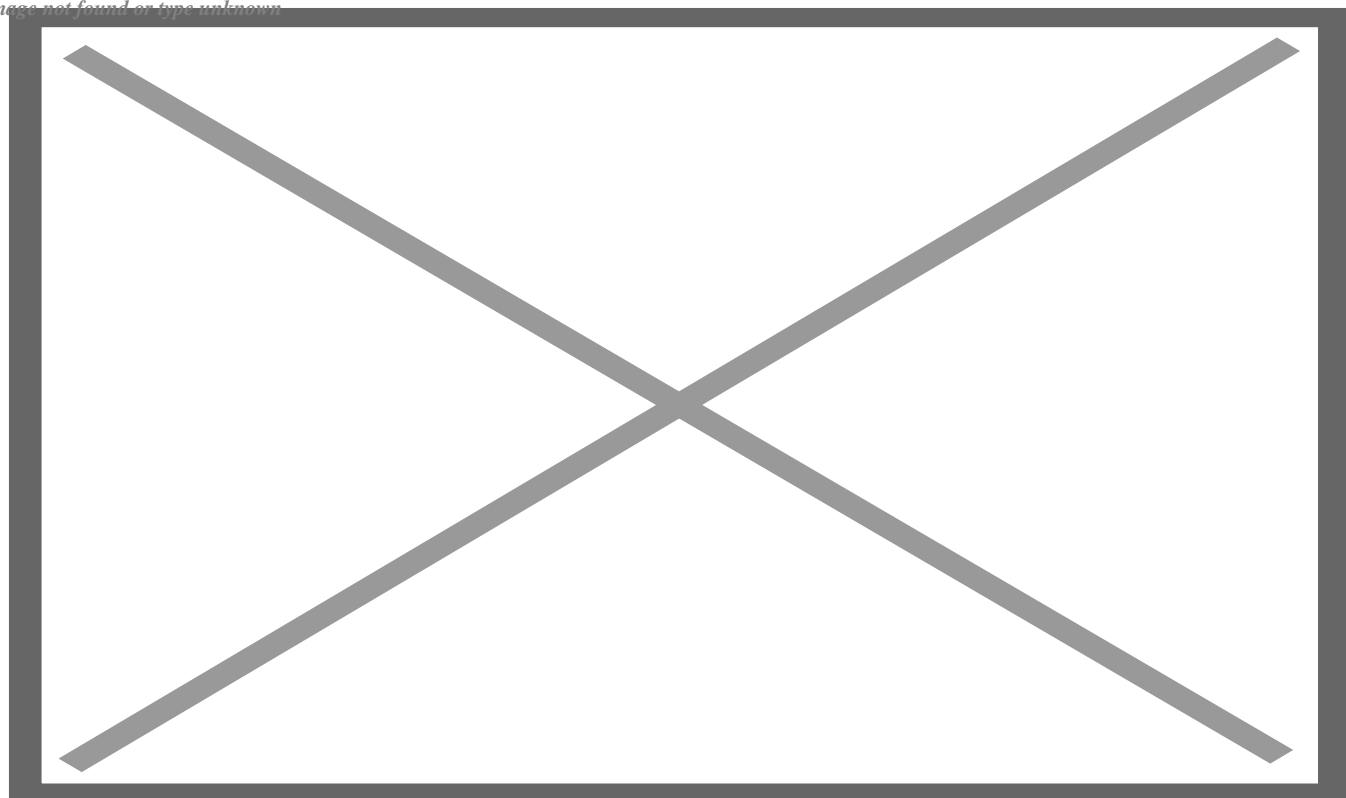


Central Committee of the Communist Party of Cuba announces its VII Plenary Session
