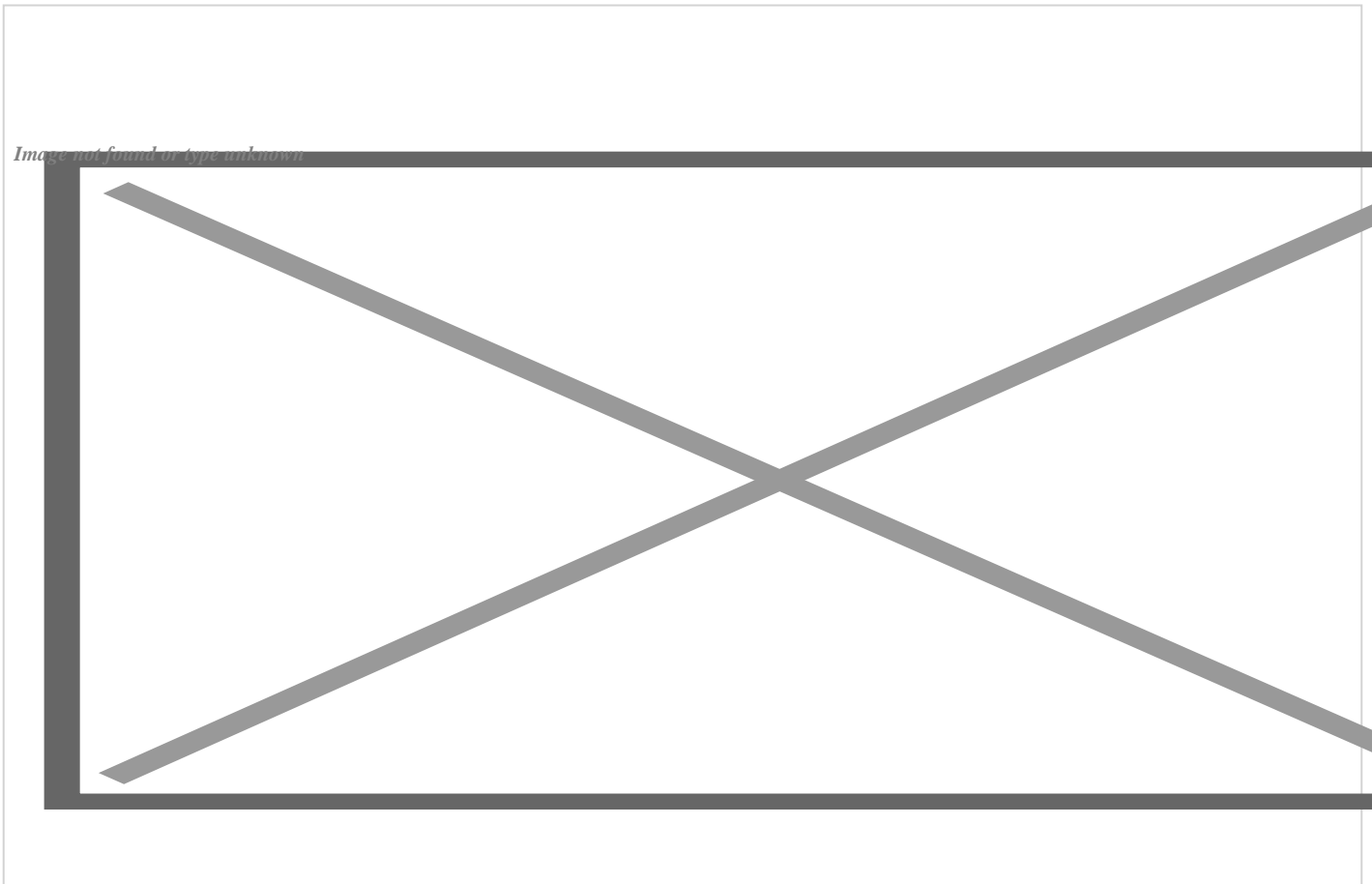


# *Cuban authorities evoke José Martí on his 171st anniversary*

Havana, January 28 (Web Network)= The First Secretary of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of Cuba and President of the Republic, Miguel Díaz Canel evoked on Sunday the patriotic and humanist stature of José Martí (1853-1895), on the 171st anniversary of his birth.
