Havana, February 8 (RHC) -- The exhibition fair of the XIV International Congress of Higher Education University 2024 illustrates today the results of the application of science and innovation in Cuban

universities.

More than thirty stands, belonging to 34 Cuban universities, show the progress made in this field, which is a pillar in the government's management system.

According to the Vice Minister of Higher Education, Reynaldo Velázquez, the role of universities in the development of processes that depend on science and innovation is recognized as never before.
