
Díaz-Canel makes an official visit to Russia to address priorities of the bilateral agenda

Havana, May 6 (RHC)-- The First Secretary of the Party and President of the Republic, Miguel Díaz-Canel Bermúdez, left this Monday afternoon for the Russian Federation on an official visit, to address priorities of the bilateral agenda.
