

Foreign ministers of China and Cuba reaffirm the good state of relations

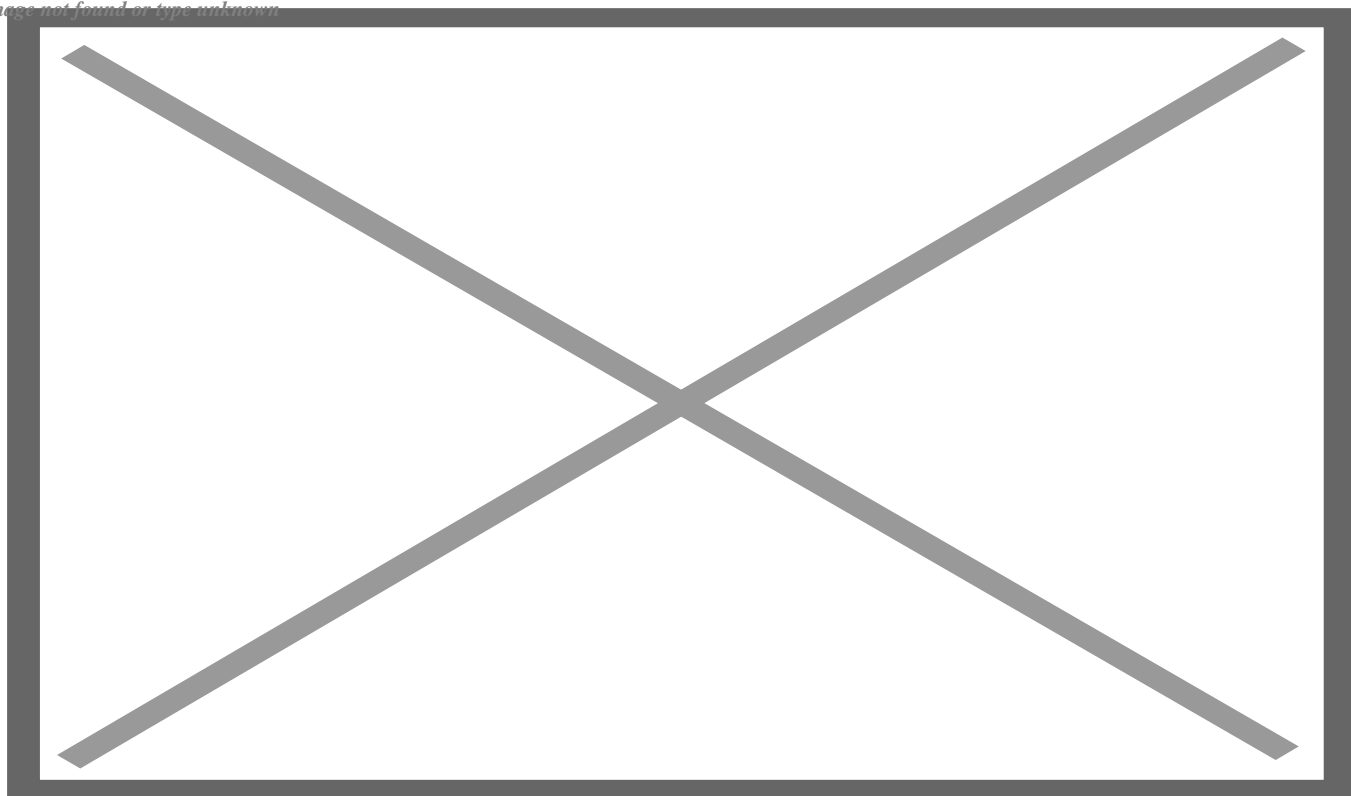

Havana, June 7 (RHC)-- The excellent state of diplomatic relations, historical ties, brotherhood and friendship between China and Cuba was highlighted by the Ministers of Foreign Affairs, Bruno Rodríguez, member of the Political Bureau of the Party and Wang Yi.

Wang Yi, who is also member of the Political Bureau and Head of the Office of the Central Foreign Affairs Commission of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of China, highlighted Beijing's position in support of the lifting of the economic, commercial and financial blockade imposed by the United States government. against Cuba. Likewise, he rejected the arbitrary and unilateral inclusion of Havana on the

list of state sponsors of terrorism.

For his part, Cuba's foreign minister, who is making an official visit as a special envoy of Cuban President Miguel Diaz-Canel, ratified his country's position in favor of the principle of one China. Likewise, he highlighted Beijing's efforts for national reunification and condemned interference in the internal affairs of the Asian giant.

The foreign ministers referred to the high level of coordination and political consensus between the leaders of the two nations in the development and strengthening of political dialogue, core issues of mutual interest, and the gradual progress in the construction of a community with a shared future between Cuba and China.
