
Las Tunas Lumberjacks prolong their dominance over Leones de Industriales



Havana, June 9 (RHC) -- On the Saturday corresponding to the 63rd National Baseball Series, the current champions, Leñadores de las Tunas, defeated the Leones de Industriales 7-3, with success for Rubén Rodríguez, disaster for Fher Eyebrows and Denis Peña's thirteenth home run.

For their part, the Guantánamo Indians beat the championship leaders, Vegueros de Pinar del Río 10-2. Orlandis Martínez won, Yoel Tejada scored the save, José Román lost, while Robert Luis Delgado and Wilber Moreira hit full return hits.

The Alazanes de Granma became the second team to qualify for the postseason, after having a 23-0 Super knockout of the Pirates of the Island. César García won and Lázaro Guerrero lost.

The Toros de Camagüey have forgotten to win at the peak of the season, and fell again to the Gallos de Sancti Spiritus with a score of 12-4. José Eduardo Santos left smiling and Abraham Licea left with his head down. Duniesky Barroso knocked it out of the park.

The Ciego de Ávila Tigers were better 8-3 than the Cienfuegos Elephants. The victory was on Ediel Ponce's record and the failure was on Pedro Soca's account. Fernando de la Paz and Osvaldo Vázquez hit home runs.

One of the most stable teams in recent years, the Matanzas Crocodiles, defeated the Holguín Cubs 8-5. Roilan Averohff triumphed, and Wilson Paredes succumbed. Jorge Blanco scored the rescue. Luis Sánchez, Andrys Pérez and Luis Santiesteban homered.

Finally, the Hurricanes of Mayabeque closely defeated the Azucareros de Villa Clara 6-5, with winning work by Yusdel Tuero, save by Adrián Sosa and home runs by Yasniel González and Osmel Cordero. Pedro Castillo suffered the setback.

The duel between the Wasps of Santiago de Cuba and the Cazadores de Artemisa was suspended due to rain. Today these subseries end.
