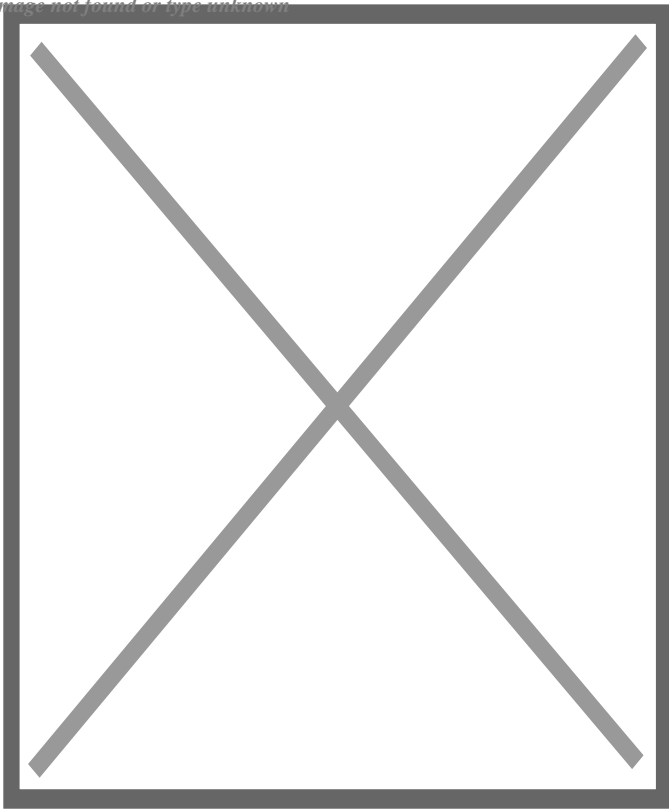


Manu Pineda calls for unity and fraternity in face of attempted coup in Bolivia

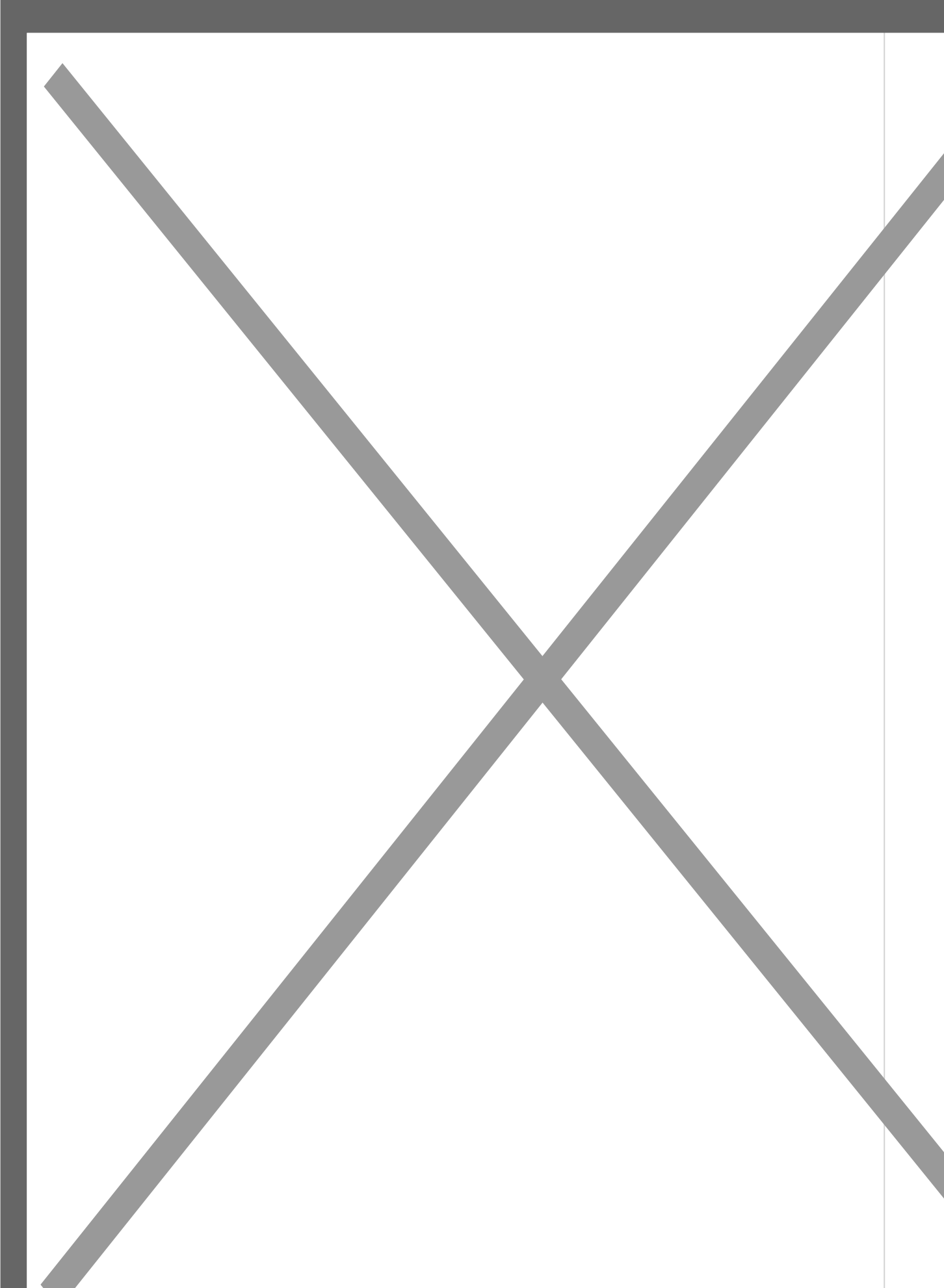

Madrid, July 1 (RHC)-- A prominent Spanish political activist has called for unity and fraternity in Bolivia, following last week's attempted military coup.
