The Las Tunas-Ciego duel will be resumed on Friday with the local Tunas team ahead 3-2.

Finally, Matanzas defeated Granma 4x1, with the second victory of the reinstated left-hander Yoanni Yera and the third rescue of Noelvis Entenza.

On offense, Adrián Pérez, who hit 4-2, with a triple and a RBI, was outstanding for the Cocodrilos.
