

Havana Will Host 2nd Meeting on Geology and Society



Havana, October 10 (RHC) -- The social and cultural connotation of Cuba's geological heritage will be the focus of discussions during the 2nd Meeting on Geology and Society that will session in Havana next October 23rd and 24th, the organizing committee announced.

Among other topics of discussion, participants will address geoparks and areas of special geological interest, said Roberto Domech, a researcher at the Cuban Institute of Geology and paleontology.

The program of the meeting, that will take place in the 'Sala Atril' of the Karl Marx Theater, includes a group of conferences on geodiversity, geopreservation and the economic and cultural impact of these issues, as well as ways to promote the interest of new generations in Earth sciences.

The agenda includes the launching of several publications and the acknowledgement of prominent geologists. There will also be a space for different exchanges with children and teenagers who have an interest in geology.
