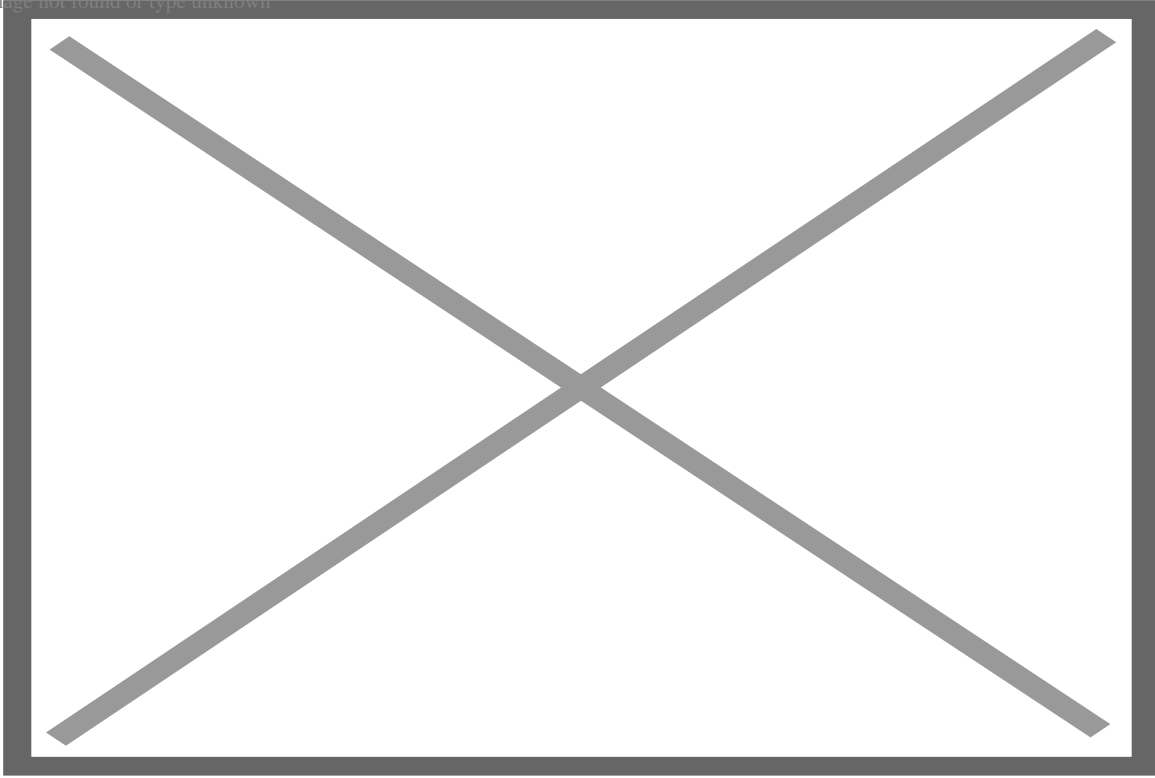

Paris Aug, 29 (JIT) - The performance of Lisbeth Rodriguez (K44) in the 47 kg division of parataekwondo marked Cuba's debut in the Paralympic Games, which are already in full swing in this city.

Unfortunately, the outcome was negative, as she lost 11-21 to the Afghan Zakia Khudadadi, representative of the refugee team.

Rodriguez found in the Grand Palais a stage with an audience that supported Khudadadi, resident in Paris.

Later, Leydis Posada (ST) also competed in the individual recurve archery competition.

At the end of the 12 rounds of six shots, she scored 462 points, which placed her 23rd in the ranking.

Her opponent in the round of 16 in the elimination round will be Turkey's Yagmur Sengul, who finished tenth with 579 units, her best record of the season.
