
Seminar on Parliamentary Diplomacy will conclude in Cuba



Havana, September 19 (RHC) The 1st International Seminar on Parliamentary Diplomacy will conclude today in Havana, after opening this Wednesday with the participation of legislators, leaders, scholars and researchers from 18 countries.
